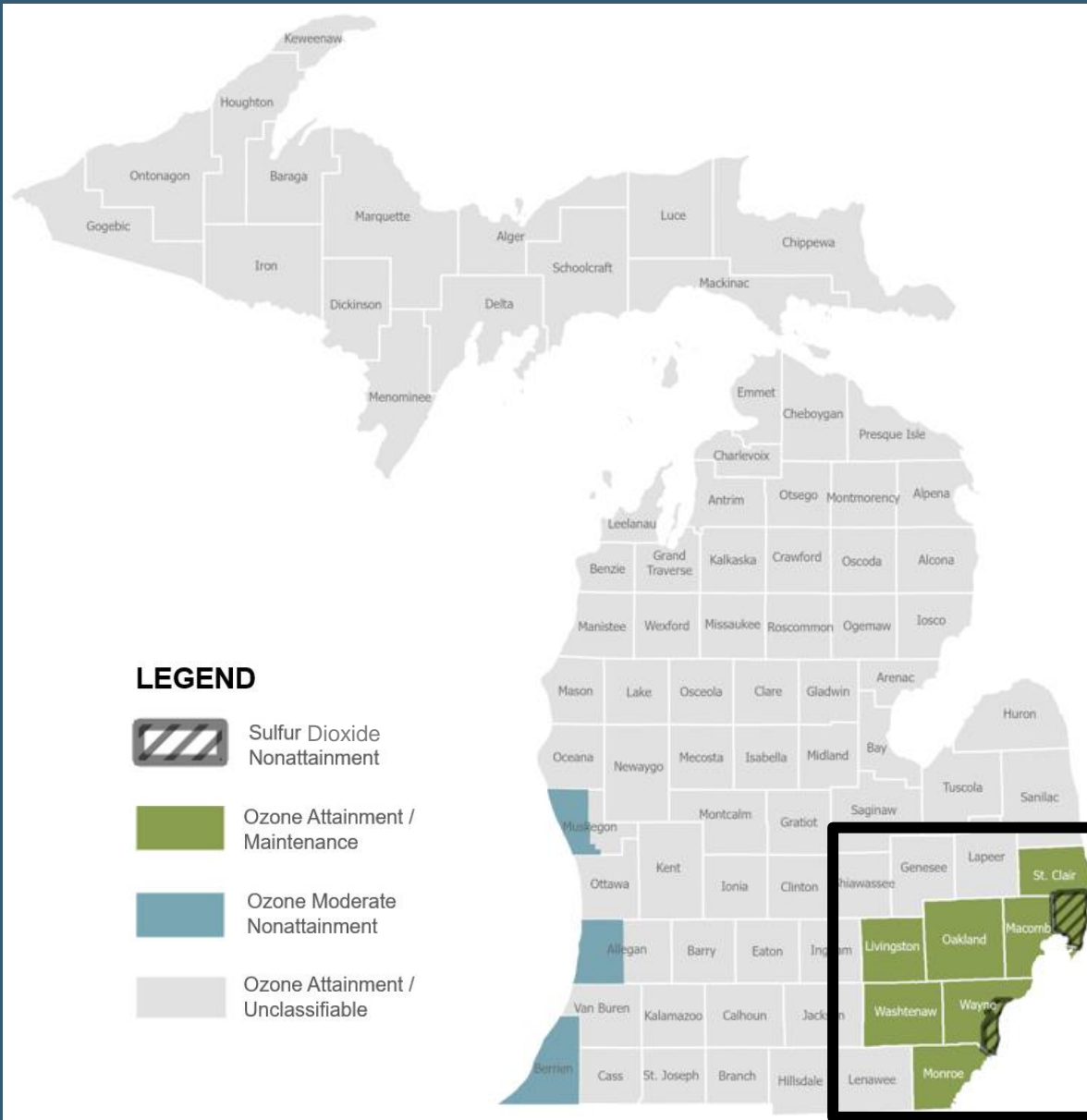

NAAQS Attainment Status Map

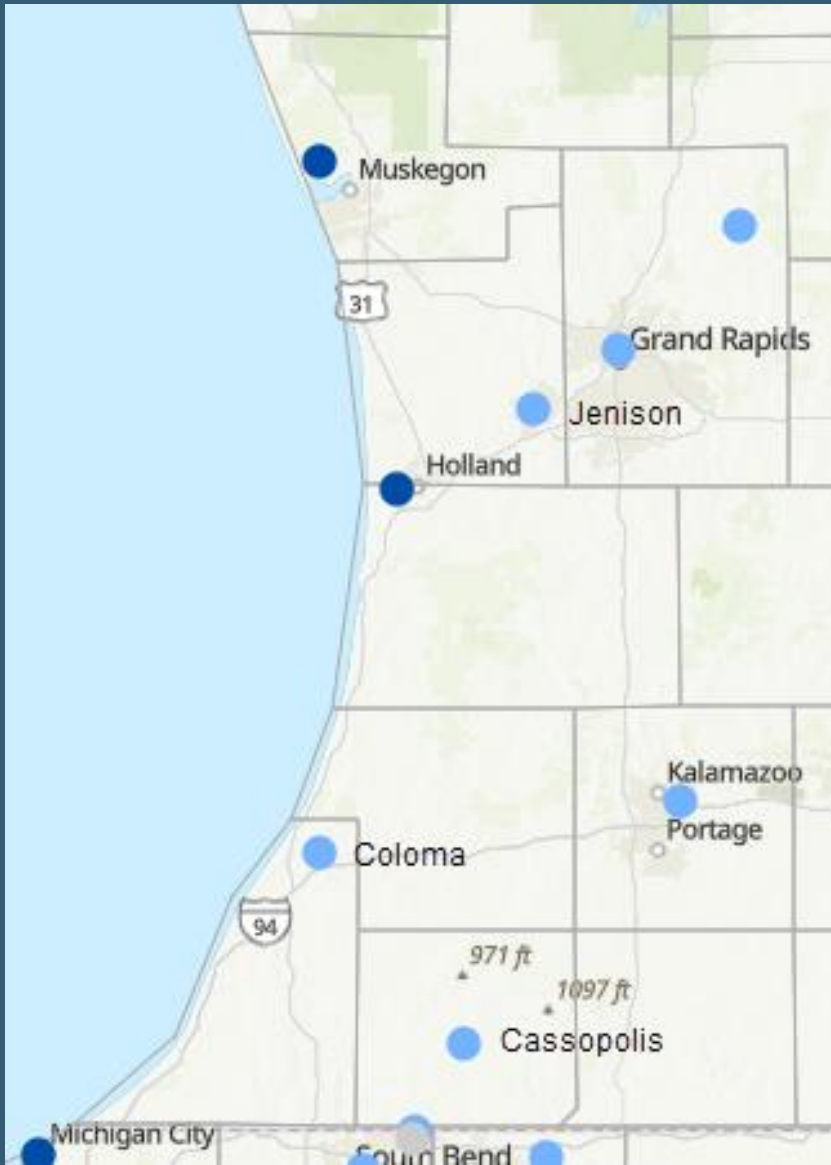




Southeast Michigan Ozone

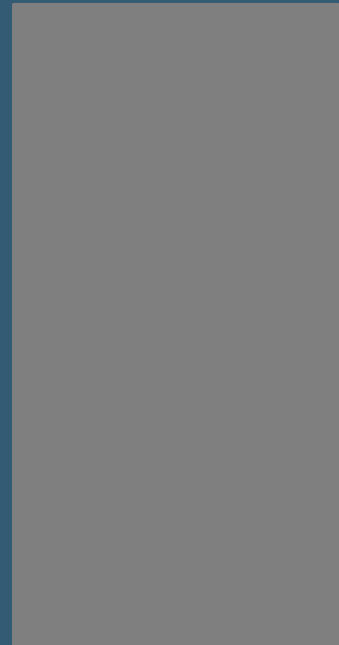

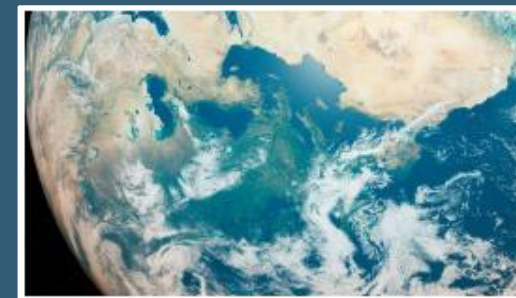

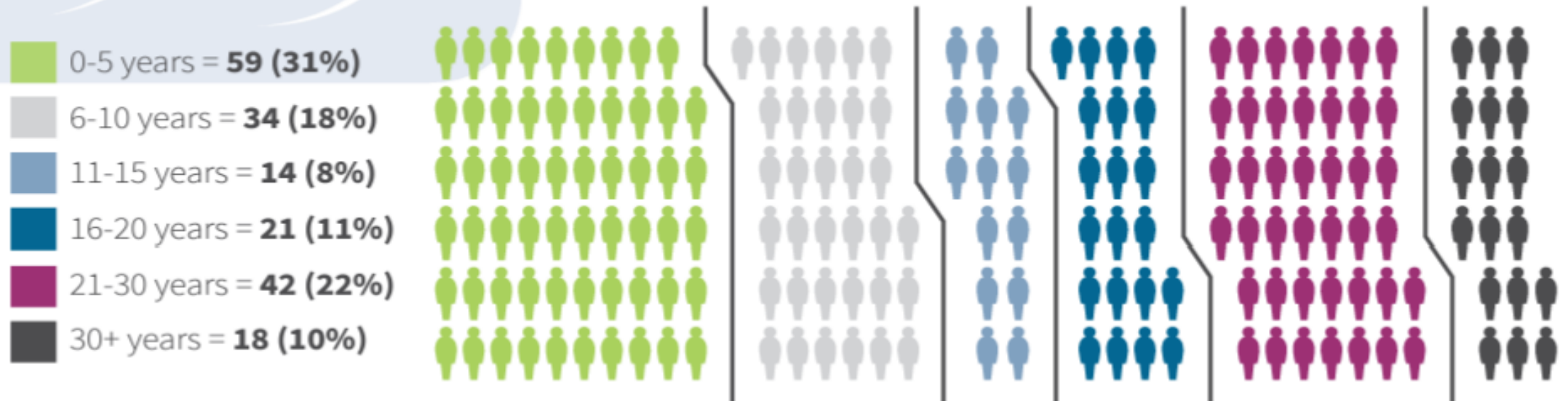
