# Air Quality Division 2021 Accomplishments

- Pre-construction permit actions = 529
- Renewable Operating permit actions = 56
- Inspections = 892
- Air Complaints Received and Resolved = 1552
- Monitored outdoor air at over 43 sites, with 100+ monitors
- Emission reports received from industry = 1,700+
- Asbestos removal notifications received = 39,777
- Asbestos inspections completed = 2034
- Violation notices issued = 348
- Enforcement cases = 28
- Over 5,000 people participated in 9 Webinars/Trainings
- Over 8000 email list subscribers

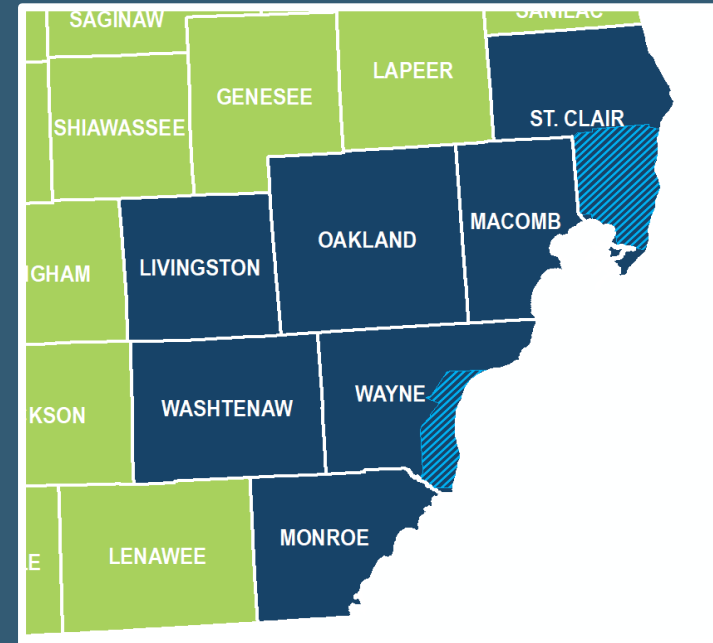
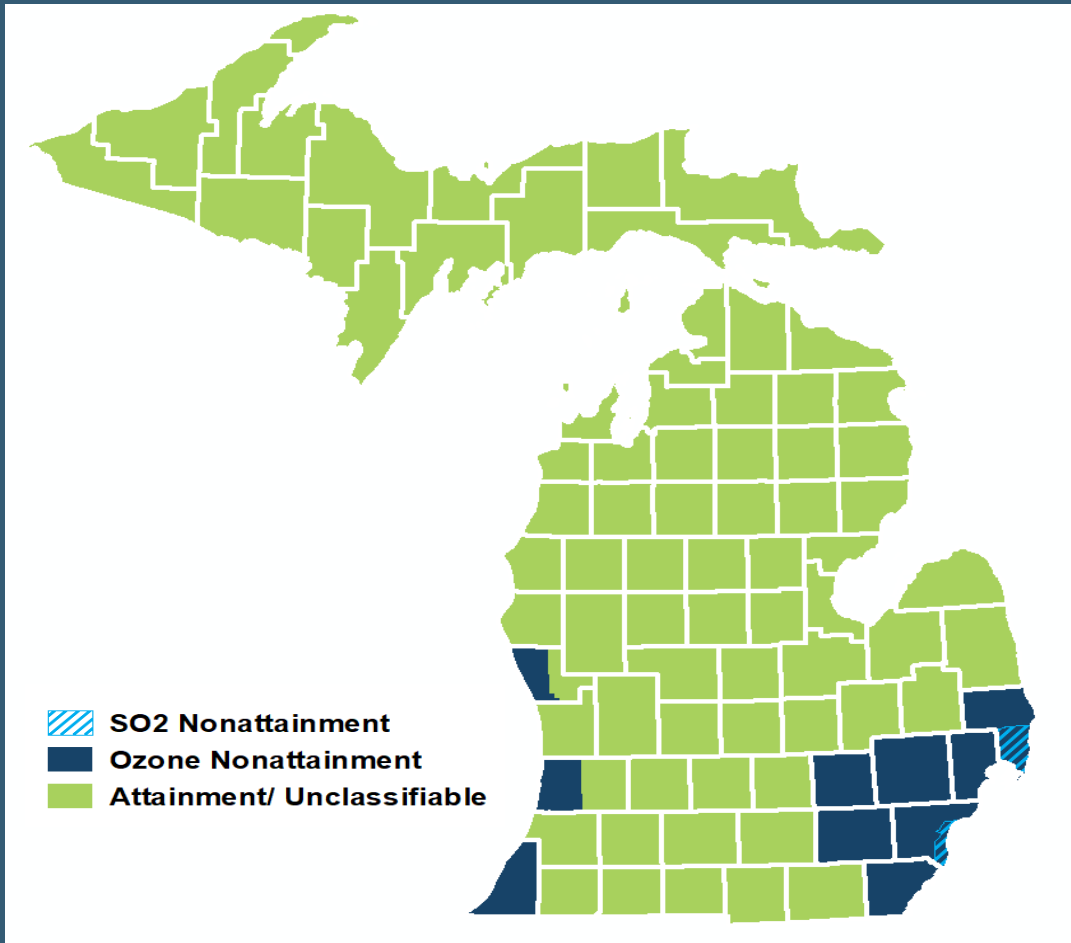

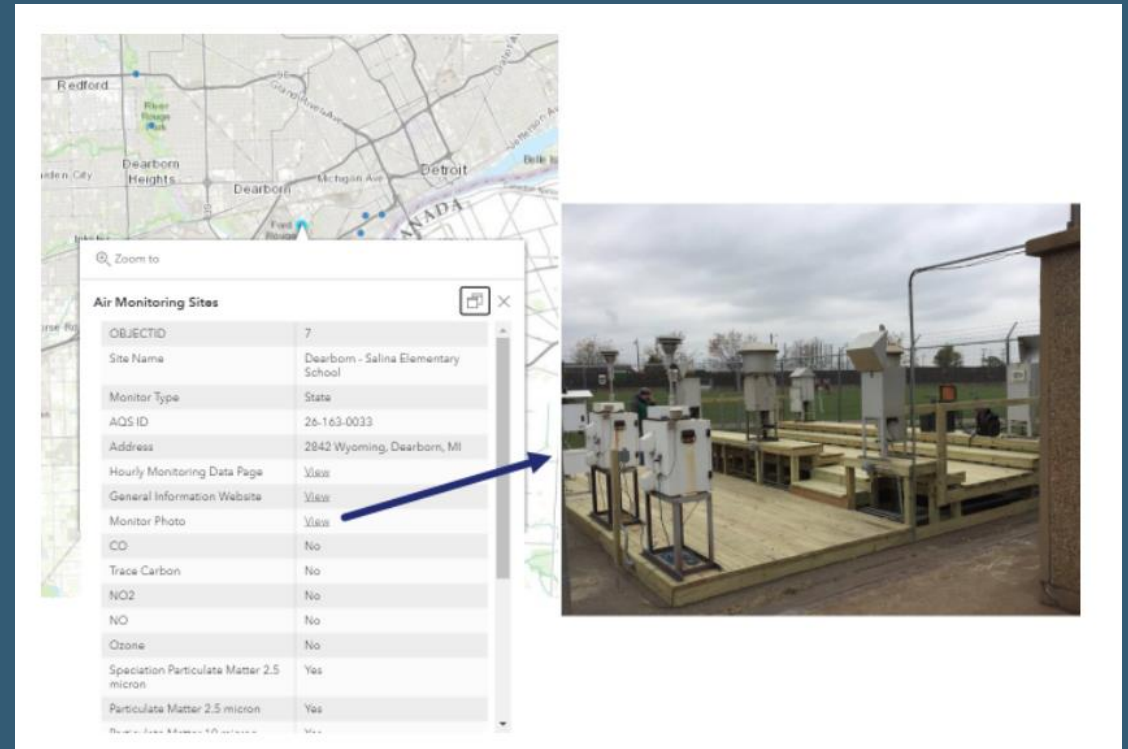
On February 28, 2022, EPA proposed Federal Implementation Plan or Good Neighbor Plan for the 2015 Ozone NAAQS

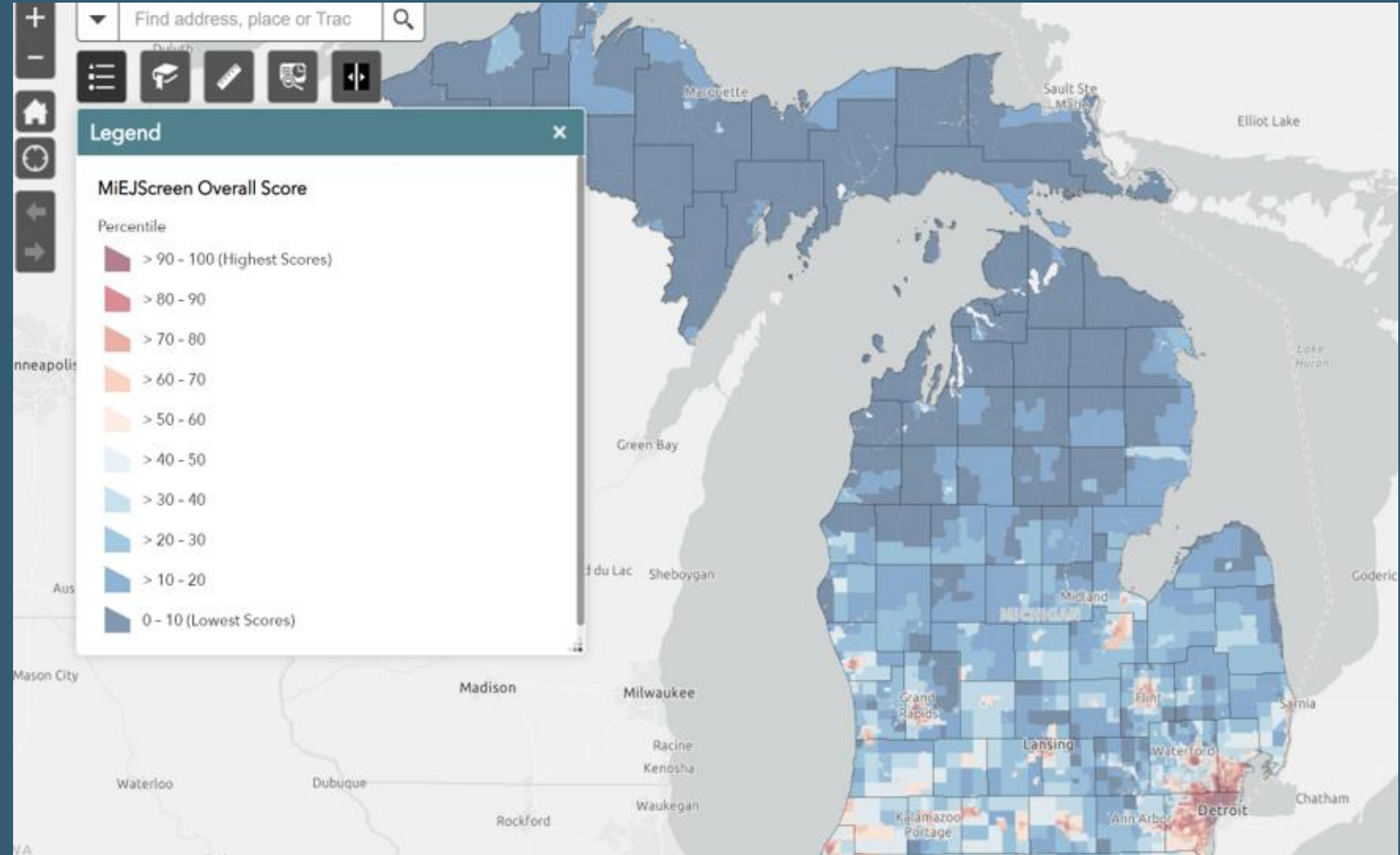
