Goals

Provide an overview of the reporting requirements for hazardous waste and liquid industrial by-products (LIB):

- Biennial Report (BR) for Large Quantity Generators (LQG)
- LIB Annual Report
- BR for Used Oil Processor
- Re-Notification for Small Quantity Generators (SQG)

Biennial Reporting

- Requirement for LQG ONLY
- Due March 1st of the even year, reporting hazardous waste generated the previous calendar year
- Must report consolidated VSQG waste received from off-site along with LQG generated waste for previous calendar year

Biennial Reporting

Who Must Report?

- If you generated, in any month, 1000 kg. (2200 lbs.) or more of hazardous waste
- If you generated, in a calendar month, or accumulates at any time, more than 1 kg. (2.2 lbs.) per month of acute hazardous waste
- If you generated, in a calendar month, or accumulates at any time, more than 100 kg. (220 lbs.) of residue or contaminated soil or debris resulting from the cleanup of a spill

Biennial Reporting



- BR is submitted electronically via [RCRA info](#)

- Report is also known as the Hazardous Waste Report or EPA Form 8700-13 A/B

Biennial Reporting

- LQG must re-notify by March 1st of each even-numbered year by submitting the Site ID Form or [EQP5150](#)
- LQG may submit this re-notification as part of its BR requirement
- E-mail scanned, signed, fully completed Site ID form to:

LIB Annual Report

- LIB Designated Facility (receiving facility) must submit LIB Annual Report detailing their LIB activities occurring from January 1st to December 31st in the prior year
- Report is due April 30th each year
- Designated Facilities complete [EQP1602](#)
- E-mail fully completed form to:
EGLE-Part-121-Reporting@Michigan.gov

LIB Annual Report

Examples of LIB include:

- Storm sewer and certain sanitary sewer clean-out wastes
- Catch basin wastes from places like car washes and auto repair shops
- Antifreeze
- Food processing and slaughterhouse wastes
- Power washing wastewaters and sludges

LIB Annual Report

Examples of LIB include:

- Used oil
- VSQG Liquids
- Brine
- Animal and vegetable fats
- Leachate
- Non-hazardous remediation wastewaters and sludges

Used Oil Processor Biennial Report

Used oil processors must report on a biennial basis, March 1st of each even year, information concerning used oil activities during the previous year, odd year.

Biennial Used Oil Processor Report

The report must include the following:

- Calendar year that the report covers
- Name and address of the company and its Site ID Number
- Amount of used oil accepted for processing.
- Description how the oil is processed, including the specific processes employed.
- Contact name and phone

Re-Notification for Small Quantity Generators (SQG)

- SQG shall re-notify starting in 2021 and every 4 years thereafter
- Re-notification must be submitted by September 1st of each year in which the re-notifications are required
- Next re-notification is due September 1, 2025

Re-Notification for Small Quantity Generators (SQG)

- SQG needs to complete and submit the Site ID Form [EQP 5150](#)
