- 5/3/2017 90% Drawings & Specifications
- Inquiry to EGLE into need for permit
- Notice to close Ash Lagoon
- 10/27/2017 Received initial sampling results
- Determined Closure Procedures
- 4/1/2019 EGLE Approved Closure Plan




Timeline

Did you know they are finding PFAS in incinerator ash?


- 6/19/2019 Began determining limits of impact
- 1/6/2020 PFAS added to list of parameters
- 1/13/2020 Received PFAS limits
- 3/3/2020 Lab report indicated PFAS
- 3/25/2020 Received PFAS work plan \$272,000
- 3/31/2020 Informed of inclusion on MPART site
- 4/29/2020 Email to City Manager




Source Removal Soil Values Landfill costs

- Offsite impacts




