

Part 213 Leaking Underground Storage Tanks

- 8K+ open sites
- 54% of back log are 20+ years old and most of these are no longer active UST facilities.
- Obstacles
- We need to work with the regulated community.



Part 201 Contaminated Sites Challenges

- Limited data for site assessments
 - Many unknowns
 - Data base management
- Self implementing program
- Cost

EGLE's Initial Response


- Soil and groundwater sampling (2018)
- Building demolition and discovery of damaged sewer pipe (2019)
- Vapor sampling and installation of mitigation systems (2019-2020)
- Decision made to remove contaminated soil on the residential properties



Installing vapor mitigation systems

Excavation at Residential Properties

November-December 2020

4,134 tons of contaminated soil removed









January 2021
Garages and driveways rebuilt



Spring 2021
Landscaping and
fencing installed



Removal of Source Contamination

on the former Forbes Dry Cleaner property

December 2021 to June 2022



Removal of 10,800 tons of contaminated soil (2,200 tons classified as Hazardous Waste)



Mixing absorbent material into backfill to treat groundwater



Brownfield Redevelopment



- 2022 Metrics
 - \$26.4 million in incentives
 - 70 projects in 47 communities
 - ROI \$32 per \$1 invested
