#### Executive Order 2019-7

- Created Marijuana Regulatory Agency
- Eliminated Medical Marihuana Licensing Board and Marihuana Advisory Panel
- Supports efficiency in operations
- Allows for consistency in implementation and ongoing approach to medical and adult-use regulatory programs
- MRA public meetings and work groups



#### Michigan Medical Marihuana Act (2008)

- Patient and caregiver registry
  - 268,566 patients (469 minors)
  - 36,757 caregivers
- Physician certification required
  - Qualifying debilitating medical condition
- Online application process and temporary registration
- Registry card program, not a regulatory program



# Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act (2016)

- Commercial licensure and regulatory program
  - 1,234 prequalified entities
  - 414 licenses approved (169 growers, 26 processors, 199 provisioning centers, 14 transporters, 6 labs)
  - \$303M in retail sales
- Administrative rules
  - Safety standards
  - Fees
    - Application \$6,000
    - Regulatory Assessment \$10,000-\$67,000
- Municipal "opt-in"
- Statewide monitoring system
- Banking



# Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act (2018)

- Commercial licensure and regulatory program
  - 113 prequalified entities
  - 51 licenses approved (13 growers, 5 processors, 26 retailers, 4 transporters, 1 lab, 2 event organizers)
  - \$8.3M in retail sales
- Administrative rules
  - Excess grower, event organizer, temporary event, designated consumption establishment
  - Fees
    - Application \$6,000
    - License \$3,000-\$50,000
- Municipal "opt-out"
- Excise tax 10%
- Social equity program
