Ozone Health Effects

- Lung irritant
- Reduces lung function
- Causes inflammation



Past Ozone Standards

Year	Standard	Michigan Attainment Status	Classification
2008	75 ppb	Attainment	--
1997	80 ppb	Nonattainment Areas	Marginal
1979	120 ppb	Nonattainment Areas	Moderate

2015 Ozone Standard History

October 2015

Ozone standard lowered to 70 ppb

November 2017

EPA designates Attainment/Unclassifiable areas

October 2016

Michigan submits designation recommendations

December 2017

EPA letter of proposed actions

February 2018

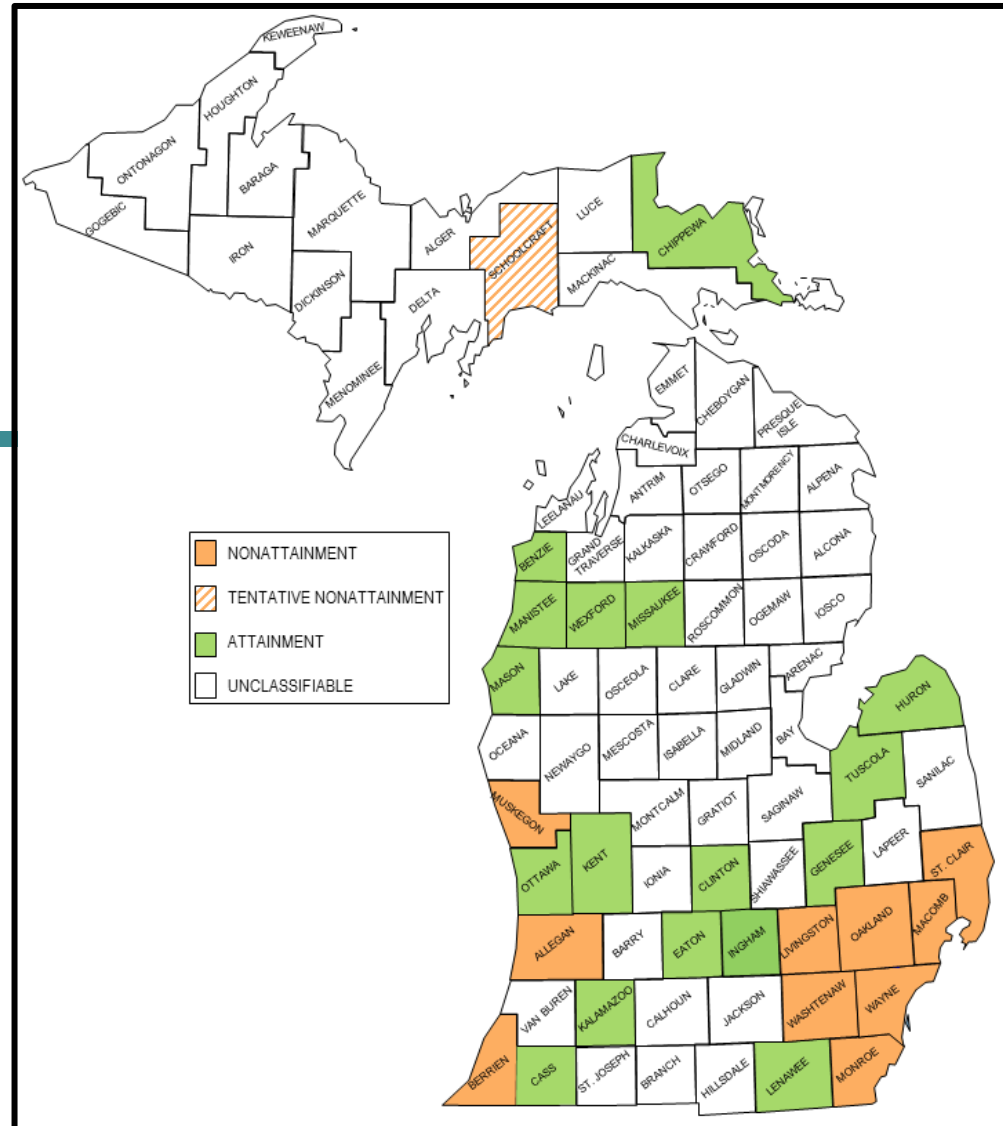

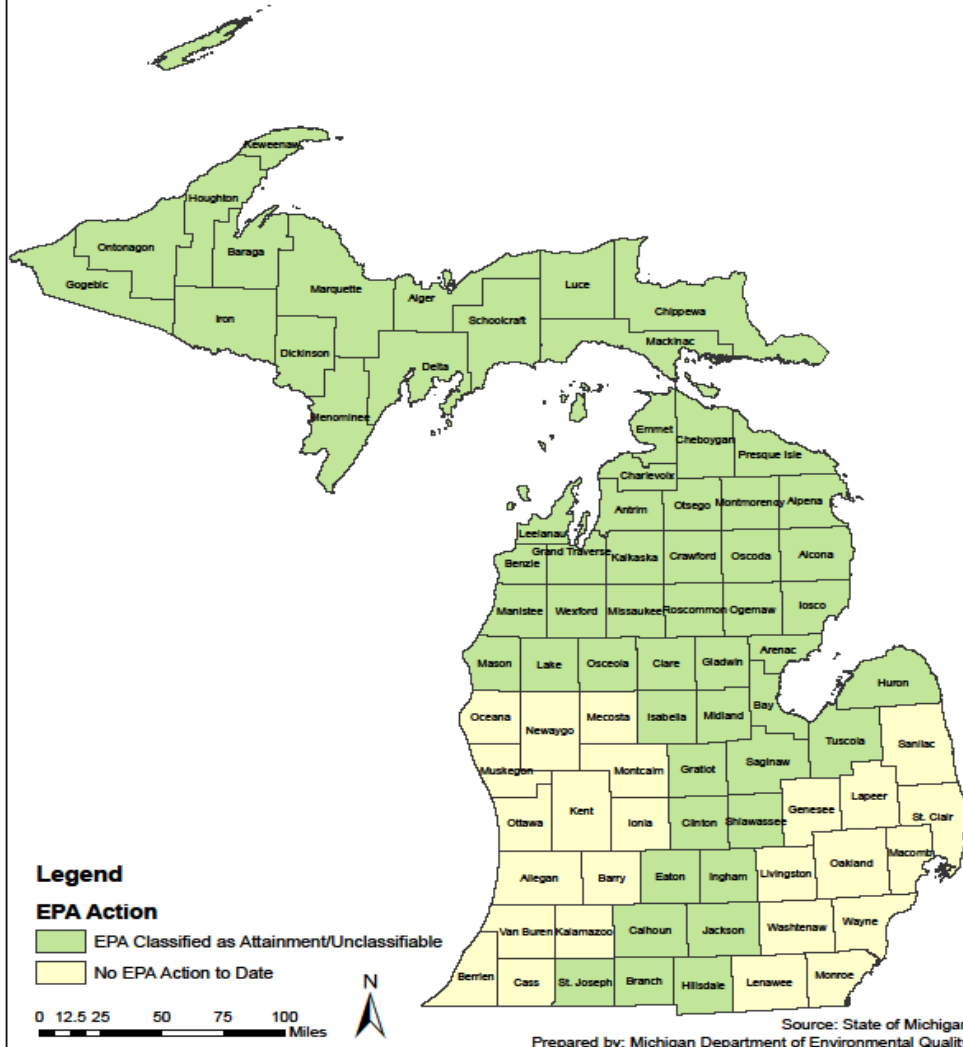

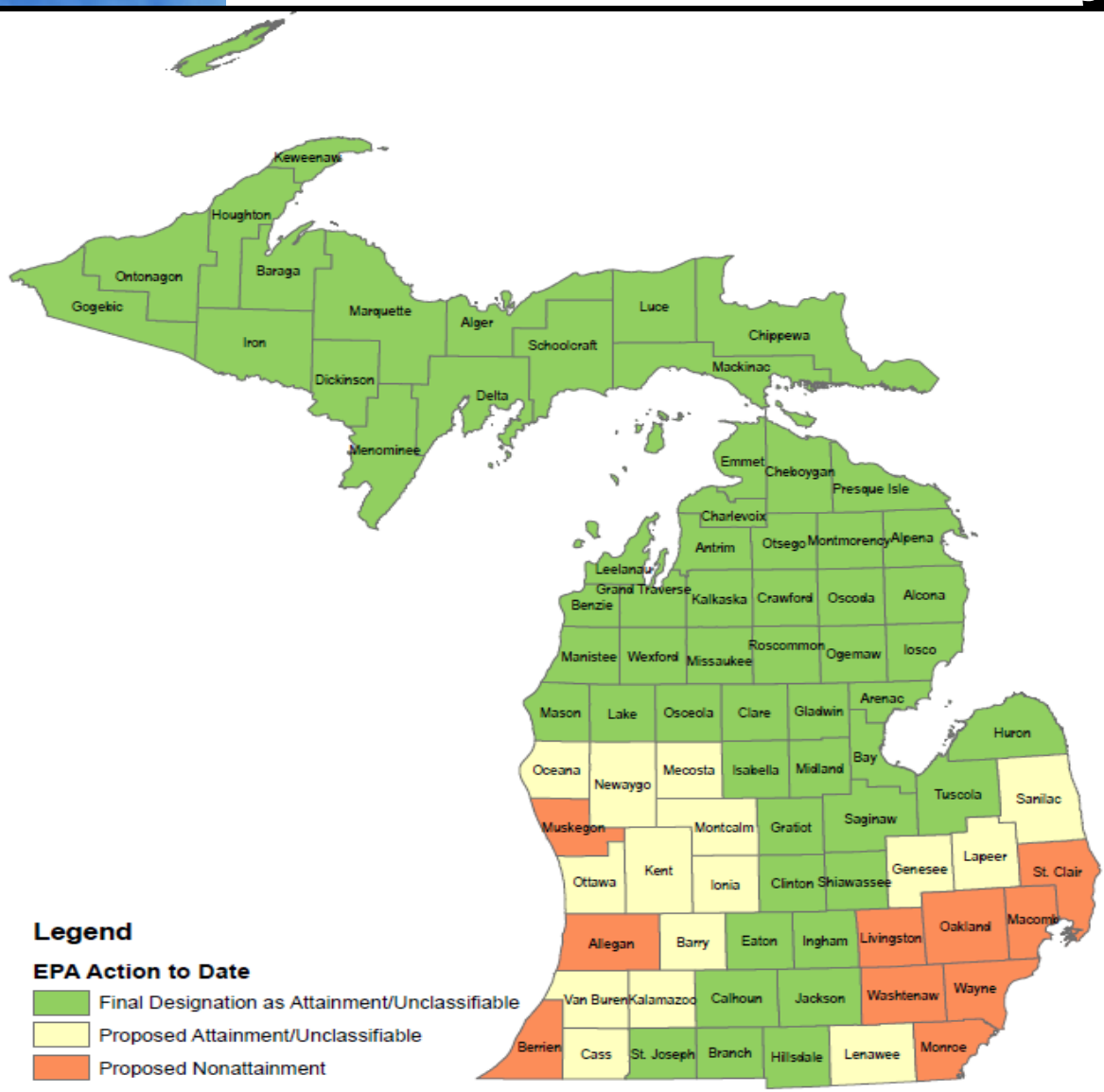
Final Ozone Designations for the 2015 Ozone Standard as of November 7, 2017

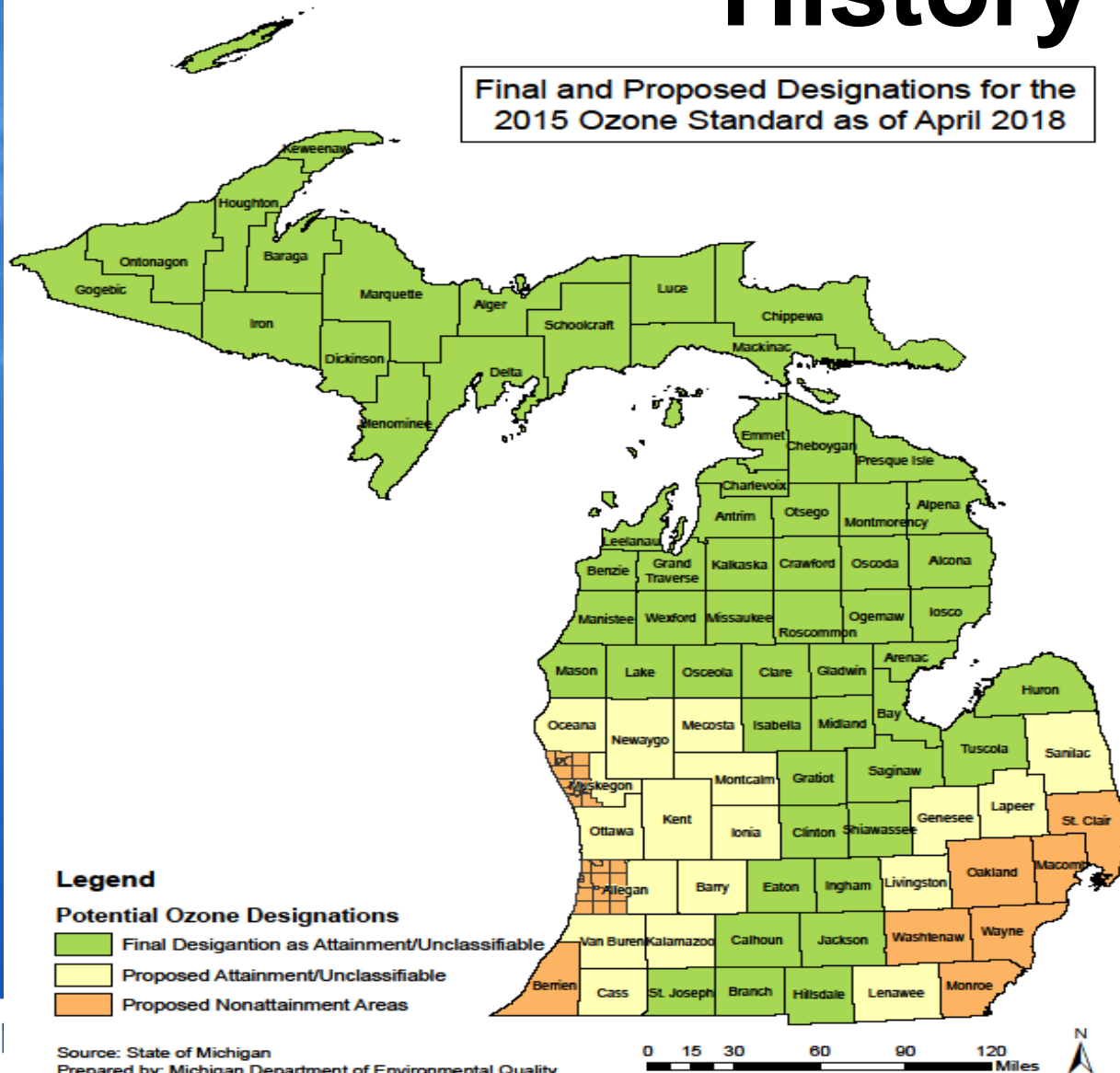

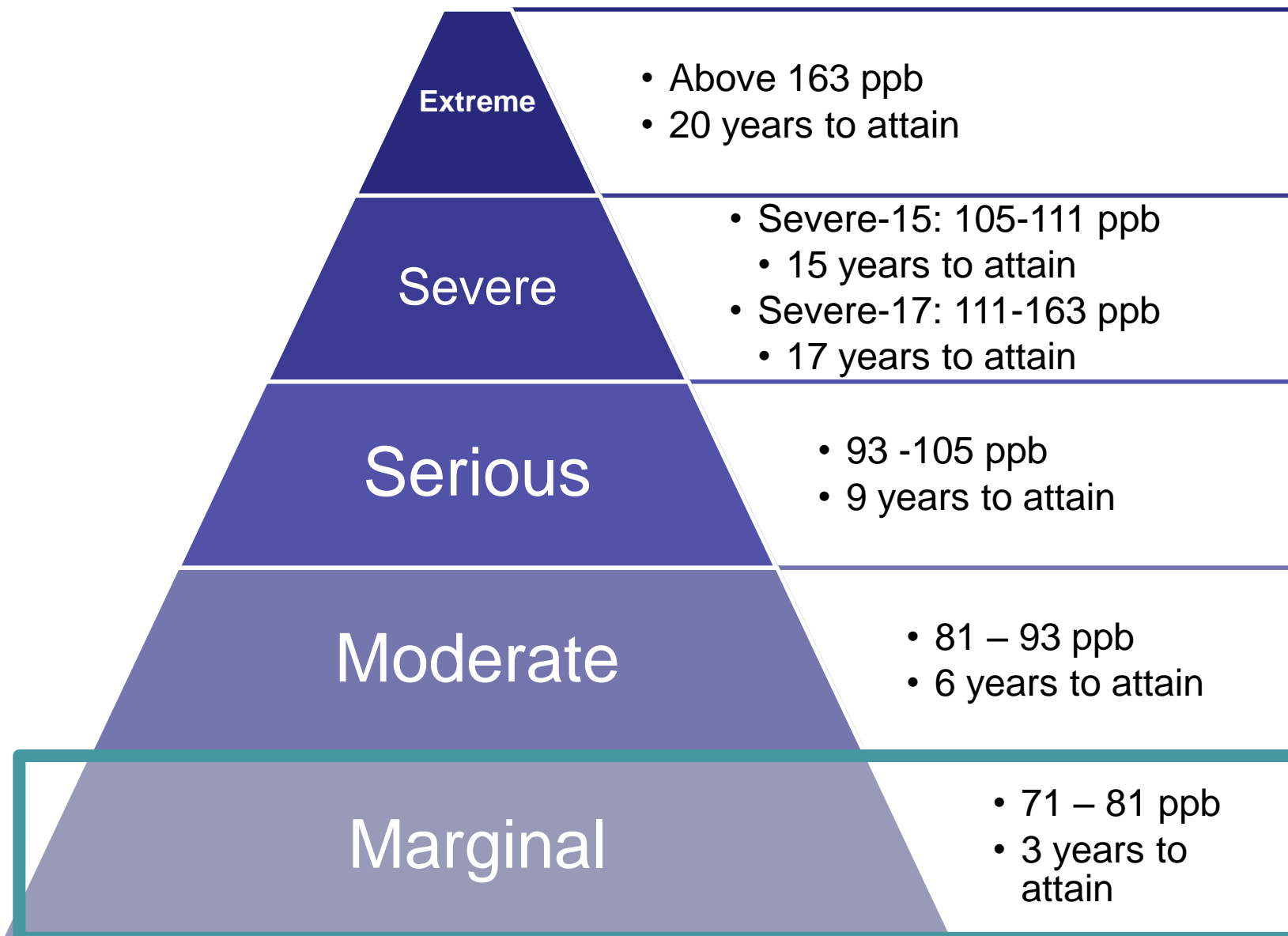

Baseline Year

- Act 451 5505(2):

“The start date for the emissions offsets eligible to be applied to a permit to install shall be the date established by federal rule or, if a date is not established by federal rule, January 1 of the year after the emissions baseline year used for the purpose of preparing the relevant state implementation plan.”
- DC Circuit Court: baseline year must have a statutory basis

What Happens If We Don't Attain in 3 Years?

- Bump up to Moderate classification

Requirement	Marginal	Moderate
NSR Offsets	1.1 to 1	1.15 to 1
Attainment Date	3 years	6 years
VOC and NOx RACT	No	Yes
15% VOC RFP Reductions	No	Yes
Basic I/M Program	No	Yes
Stage II Gasoline Vapor Recovery	No	Yes

VOC and NOx RACT

- VOC RACT
 - Based on Control Technique Guidelines
 - MI considering as part of 2015 ozone attainment plan
- NOx RACT
 - CSAPR Update
 - CAIR

Additional Moderate Requirements

- Additional 15% VOC reductions
- Basic Vehicle Inspection and Maintenance Program
- Stage II Gasoline Vapor Recovery



What Happens If We Don't Submit a SIP in time?

- Federal Implementation Plan (FIP)
- Sanctions
 - NSR offset ratio of at least 2 to 1
 - Highway funding sanctions
